		McLeod Plantation, historic site nearest Folly	<p>There are rave reviews for the number one easily accessible historical site for Folly Beach: McLeod Plantation is located 8 miles from Folly Beach on highway 171, open 9-4. Known for its row of slave cabins, the Plantation focuses on the period after the Civil War until the modern Civil Rights movement, but it also provides an accurate understanding of the role of cotton production, which depended on slavery, in leading to the Civil War. Check the website for when there is a talk by the site's excellent guides; times change according to the season. The small gift area offers inexpensive but well-chosen items. Requires about 1.5 hours to visit. Those who do not walk or stand easily are accommodated with a golf cart.
